Post A – Student Photographer

- 1. Responsibilities
- Capture the event's highlights and edit photos for publicity purposes. Photos will be posted on the social media and website of CEDARS.

- HKU current students with a keen interest in photography;
- Proficiency in photo editing skills, e.g. Adobe Photoshop;
- Availability of own cameras;
- Experience in capturing photos at events and sports programmes;
- Attendance for all requested events strongly preferred;
- Sharing of a photography portfolio strongly preferred.

- Sharing of a videography/Instagram portfolio strongly preferred

- HKU current students with a keen interest in graphic design
- Proficiency in design skills, including the use of graphic design software such as Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Canva or InDesign
- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines
- Sharing of graphic design portfolio strongly preferred

3. Rewards

Upon satisfactory performance and attendance, student graphic designer will be entitled to an honorarium of up to **HK\$500 for each set of publicity material produced** as well as service points under the <u>CEDARS Reward Scheme</u>
